# **Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)**

#### **DESCRIPTION**

NRC developed a variety of ethics training products: "Relationships" is a light-hearted introduction to make employees think more broadly about whether a relationship with a contractor might create a perception of impropriety; "Bad Guys Photo Album" features prominent individuals who have violated ethics laws and briefly describes the offense. "Tales from the Ethics Crypt" allows employees to apply their ethics knowledge in various fact patterns. "Myths about Seeking Employment and Post-Employment Regulations" instructs senior-level employees and managers and anyone thinking of retirement or leaving Government service on the post-employment restrictions. The training was delivered live as well as on DVDs. Some of the Commissioners received personal briefings while others attended training with employees. In addition to the training products, NRC wrote an article "Staying Out of the Briar Patch: Working with Government Employees" to help those companies who do business or want to do business with the Federal Government avoid ethical lapses. Last, NRC writes an ethics column in the employee newsletter.
