Defense Finance and Accounting Service

DESCRIPTION

The Defense Finance and Accounting Service used remote voting devices for its initial ethics orientation. Employees use the devices to answer multiple choice questions anonymously, and the responses are tabulated and plotted automatically on a bar graph. The questions are based on real cases found in the Encyclopedia of Ethical Failure.

PURPOSE

The use of the remote voting devices enabled instructors to assess how well employees understood the material, tailor the training to the employees' needs, and keep the employees engaged and entertained.

PRODUCT ADAPTABILITY

This training initiative can be used by any ethics program.
