DESCRIPTION

“Ethipedia” is an online ethics guide posted on the USAID intranet for its employees who are in over 90 countries around the world. The presentation of the Standards of Conduct and the Conflict of Interest statutes include numerous real-life examples of violations for each section.

PURPOSE

The purpose of “Ethipedia” is to inform USAID’s geographically scattered employees about how to avoid pitfalls and when they should turn to agency ethics officials for assistance.

PRODUCT ADAPTABILITY

This training initiative can be used by any ethics program that possesses the standard open-source Wikipedia software platform and open-source MediaWiki software. Departments and agencies would also need someone to keep the information updated.
