Financial Disclosure Management (FDM)

DESCRIPTION

Financial Disclosure Management (FDM) is a secure, web-based financial disclosure electronic filing system for OGE Form 278 & 450. FDM automates the process used for filing disclosures in a secure, accurate, and efficient manner. FDM is government owned and operated software available to all government agencies. The Office of Government Ethics has approved FDM as an acceptable automated alternative to the paper/electronic form, creating opportunities for FDM to be used throughout the Executive Branch. The Office of Government Ethics has also declared FDM an “Agency Model Practice” for its proven record of increasing timeliness, consistency, and accuracy of the financial disclosure program.

PURPOSE

To improve and automate preparation and review of the Financial Disclosure Report.

PRODUCT ADAPTABILITY

FDM is available on a reimbursable services basis. Agencies purchasing FDM gain by receiving an “off the shelf” product ready to use in about 60 days. Several Agencies, e.g., Office of Government Ethics, Veterans Affairs, Center for Disease Control, and Department of Homeland Security are using FDM.
