DESCRIPTION

The program seeks to combine the use of speakers, an informal brown bag lunch, and other learning activities to create an environment that heightens ethics awareness.

PURPOSE

To educate the employees about the federal ethics laws, to further familiarize employees with the NIEHS Ethics Office and staff, to have the NIEHS leadership participate to underscore the importance of ethics to the agency's overall mission, and to present ethics topics and issues in a informal and interactive setting.

Any group can use the free online jeopardy program to create their own game at superteachertools.com.
