Count 1 (Acts Affecting Personal Financial Interest-Misdemeanor)

On or about August 21, 2013, in the Northern District of Georgia, the defendant, CHAD CORLISS, being an officer and employee of the executive branch of the United States Government, to wit, the United States Air Force, did participate personally and substantially as a Government officer and employee through recommendation, the rendering of advice and otherwise, in a contract and other particular matter, to wit, a contract for purchase by the United States Air Force of a medical simulator for the training of aeromedical evacuation personnel at Dobbins Air Force Reserve Base, in which defendant CORLISS knew that he had a financial interest.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 208 and 216(a)(1).

Count 2
(Acts Affecting Personal Financial Interest-Misdemeanor)

On or about January 15, 2015, in the Northern District of Georgia, the defendant, CHAD CORLISS, being an officer and employee of the executive branch of the United States Government, to wit, the United States Air Force, did participate personally and substantially as a Government officer and employee through recommendation, the rendering of advice and otherwise, in a contract and other particular matter, to wit, a contract for purchase by the United States Air Force of a medical simulator for the training of aeromedical evacuation personnel at Dobbins Air Force Reserve Base, in which defendant CORLISS knew that he had a financial interest.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 208 and 216(a)(1).
