

ETHICS PROGRAM REVIEW FOLLOW-UP REPORT

As a result of its review of the FCC ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued four recommendations in its August 2022 review report. OGE conducted a follow-up review in September 2024 and was able to close three of the four recommendations. OGE conducted a second follow-up review to assess whether the FCC has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying the remaining recommendation. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

3	Ensure that all public financial disclosure reports are certified timely.	<p>OGE examined filing data for all public new entrant, annual, and termination reports filed at FCC during 2024. Timeliness improved immensely, from 48% in 2023 to 97%, in 2024.</p> <p>This high level of certification timeliness is indicative of a well-functioning financial disclosure program.</p>	Closed

Based on the results of OGE’s follow-up review, all recommendations are closed.
