The United States Attorney Charges:

Count One

Executive Branch Employee Participating in a Matter
Affecting the Employee's Financial Interest
(Violation of 18 U.S.C. § 208(a))

From on or about January 13, 2017, to on or about June 19, 2017, in the Northern District of Texas and elsewhere, the defendant, **Martha Arps**, being an employee of the United States Postal Service, knowingly participated personally and substantially as a government employee through decision and recommendation in a particular matter in which, to her knowledge, her spouse had financial interests, namely, through her decision and recommendation to award a contract to A-1 Professional Detail, L.L.C. to power wash a United States Post Office, in the amount of \$7,800.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 208(a).
