#### August 2013 Ethics Symposium

On August 21<sup>st</sup> the Institute for Ethics in Government in partnership with the United States Department of Agriculture Ethics Office, will host a one-day Symposium in the Jefferson Auditorium in the South Building at USDA headquarters.

The full-day event will feature sessions covering the lifecycle of a presidential appointee, including the revolving door and gifts provisions of title 18 of the US Code, title 5 of the US Code, the Standards of Conduct, and Executive Order 13490.






