THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

From in or about July 2009 and continuing through in or about February 2010, within the Northern District of Georgia, Defendant RICHARD VANNOY knowingly aided and abetted Linda Worth, an officer and employee of the Department of Veterans Affairs, an agency of the executive branch of the United States Government, in her participation personally and substantially as a Government officer and employee, through decision, approval, disapproval, recommendation, the rendering of advice, investigation, and otherwise, in a judicial and other proceeding, application, request for a ruling and other determination, contract, claim, controversy, charge, accusation, arrest, and other particular matter in which, to her knowledge, she, her spouse, minor child, general partner, organization in which she was serving as officer, director, trustee, general partner and employee, and any person and organization with whom she was negotiating and had any arrangement concerning prospective employment, had a financial interest, namely, by paying Linda Worth checks totaling \$4,000 while she was promoting, recommending, and placing orders at

the VA Medical Center-Atlanta of the medical product Procellera, a product for which defendant RICHARD VANNOY had an exclusive distribution agreement, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 208(a), 216(a)(1), and 2.
