As a result of its inspection of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued one recommendation in its September 2018 inspection report. OGE conducted a follow-up review to assess whether FDIC has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying this recommendation. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

1	Ensure that all confidential filers receive annual ethics training.	FDIC began offering live training sessions, including videoconferencing, to all of its regional offices in 2018. Employees in regional and field offices could also attend regional and field classroom ethics training, or connect to those training sessions live via webbased meeting software. Any employee not able to participate in live training completed an interactive web-based training.	Closed
		FDIC's confidential filer training completion improved from 47% during 2017 to over 99% during 2018.
