Preventing Conflicts of Interest in the Executive Branch

As a result of its review of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued two recommendations in its August 2023 review report. OGE conducted a follow-up review to assess whether NGA has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying these recommendations. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

2	Ensure the initial ethics training presentation provided to new employees contains all four of the required concepts: conflicts of interest, impartiality, misuse of position, and gifts.	NGA provided OGE with a copy of their 2024 initial ethics training presentation. The presentation contains all four of the required concepts.	Closed
