As a result of its review of the National Transportation Safety Board's ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued four recommendations in its April 2022 review report. OGE conducted a follow-up review to assess whether the NTSB has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying these recommendations. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

3	Ensure that all new employees receiving initial ethics training receive a copy of or written instructions for accessing all required written materials.	NTSB provided documentation that confirmed all new employees receive access to the required written materials. This recommendation is closed.	Closed
4	Ensure that the DAEO reviews the written procedures for providing initial ethics training.	NTSB confirmed that the DAEO completed an annual review of these written procedures on August 23, 2022. This recommendation has been closed.	Closed
