

ETHICS PROGRAM REVIEW FOLLOW-UP REPORT

As a result of its review of the NSC ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued one recommendation in its August 2023 review report. OGE conducted a follow-up review to assess whether NSC has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying this recommendation. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

1	Ensure that new entrant public financial disclosure reports are filed timely.	<p>OGE examined all eight reports required to be filed during 2024. Only three (38%) were filed timely. A report is considered timely when it is filed within 30 days of the date the employee assumes a public filer position.</p> <p>The NSC staff intends to improve timely filing of new entrant reports through improved communications between legal and human resource office staff to identify when employees assume public filer positions.</p>	Open

Based on the results of this review, the above recommendation will remain open. OGE will conduct an additional follow-up review in approximately one year to assess whether NSC has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying the open recommendation.
