



Percentage of positive responses (2013)




Effective Leadership – Senior Leaders How satisfied are you with the information you receive from management on what's going on in your organization?

Percentage of Positive Responses (2013)




Government-wide – Percentage of positive responses (2013)



Effective Leadership – Fairness "I can disclose a suspected violation of any law, rule or regulation without fear of reprisal." Percentage of positive responses (2013)




Effective Leadership – Fairness "Arbitrary action, personal favoritism and coercion for partisan political purposes are not tolerated." Percentage of positive responses (2013)
