As a result of its review of the Federal Mine Safety and Health Review Commission (FMSHRC) ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued 1 recommendation in its September 2017 review report. OGE recently conducted a follow-up review to assess whether FMSHRC has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying the recommendation.
