Beginning in or about February 2015 and continuing until in or about August 2015, in the Dallas Division of the Northern District of Texas, Defendant, Lydia Taylor, being an employee of the Department of Labor (DOL), an independent agency of the United States, knowingly participated personally and substantially as a Government officer and employee, through investigation, accessing DOL systems and claims data, or otherwise, in matters in which Taylor knew that she, as well as organizations in which she was serving as an employee, namely Union Medical Supplies and Equipment and Skycare Medical Supplies and Equipment, had a financial interest.
