I am delighted to invite you to participate in Saban Forum 2012, the ninth annual dialogue between American and Israeli leaders from across the political and social spectrum, organized by the Saban Center for Middle East Policy at the Brookings Institution. **Saban Forum 2012 will take place from Friday evening, November 30, through Sunday afternoon, December 2, 2012 at the Willard Intercontinental Hotel in Washington D.C.**

Because our past gatherings have allowed for an unparalleled level of dialogue, the Saban Forum has become a seminal event for politicians, journalists, policy experts, and leaders from the private sector to engage in a candid exchange of views and generate creative ideas for dealing with the multiple challenges that confront the United States and Israel in the Middle East.

Over the last eight years the Saban Forum has included many notable participants, including President George W. Bush, President William J.
