1. **The name and position of the traveling official**
 - Piper Anne Wind Campbell, Ambassador of the United States of America to Mongolia
2. **The identity of the non-Federal source**
 - OT LLC, d/b/a Oyu Tolgoi LLC, owned by Turquoise Hill Resources—THR (66%) and Erdenes Mongol Oyu Tolgoi LLC-EMOT (34%). Rio Tinto (RT) owns 51% of THR and EMOT is owned by Erdenes Mongol LLC, a Mongolian state-owned holding company. RT has management control of OT.

4. **The identity of other expected participants;**
 - Mr. Cameron McRae, CEO, OT LLC
5. **The amount and method of payment (in other words, will the source pay the costs directly or reimburse the traveling official)**
 - OT LLC will directly pay all costs related to the air travel to the flight company. Lunch and hospitality is planned at OT LLC 'S mining camp and will be paid for by OT LLC.
6. **The nature of the expenses to be paid by the donor (for example, transportation, lodging, meals, etc.)**
 - OT LLC will pay transportation and meal expenses in the countryside. US Embassy will use its own car for pick up/drop off at the Chinggis Khan Airport.
7. **The monetary value and character of the travel benefits offered by the non-Federal source**
 - The cost to OT LCC for the overall trip is estimated to be \$650.00
8. **A complete description of the purpose of travel**
 - The purpose of the travel for OT LLC is to celebrate the first shipment of copper concentrate from the OT mine. The event has been long planned and long delayed by OT LLC to highlight developments at Oyu Tolgoi and was not specifically designed for U.S. Embassy personnel.
 - For the Ambassador, the trip will allow post to signal its support for an official Department of Commerce Advocacy Client before key Mongolian officials and other key stakeholders in the OT project. As RT has an complex and evolving relationship with the government of Mongolia at the central, provincial, and soum levels, knowledge gained from the this trip will aid post in supporting official U.S. commercial and economic policy interests in Mongolia's key mining sector.
9. **A statement attesting that a reasonable person would not believe that the traveling official or the Department would lose objectivity as a result of acceptance of the travel offer; and**
 - Ambassador Campbell and her team attest that a reasonable person would not believe that the acceptance of OT LLC's support for travel to the OT would cause us or the Department to lose objectivity in relation to OT LLC'S activities. As an inter-agency review process supervised by the Department of Commerce has approved RT for advocacy support for the OT project, Ambassador Campbell's attendance at this event is consistent with official U.S. commercial and economic policy goals undertaken under the aegis of the official Advocacy process.
